

Wednesday - Day One

Depart from London Heathrow on our flight to Tel Aviv. On arrival we will be met and transfer to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Thursday - Day Two - Jerusalem

We drive to Bethlehem to visit the Bethlehem Shepherds' Fields and the Church of the Nativity. We then continue to Abu Ghosh, one of the sites of Emmaus.

We end the day at the Garden Tomb for a communion service.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Friday - Day Three - Jerusalem

We drive to the top of the Mount of Olives and walk down the Palm Sunday Road visiting the Church of Dominus Flevit, the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. In the afternoon we visit Mount Zion and the Church of St Peter in Gallicantu.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Saturday - Day Four - Jerusalem

We start the day at the Davidson Centre, the archaeological garden and southern steps. Continue to the Temple Mount, the Crusader Church of St Anne, the Pool of Bethesda and follow the Via Dolorosa to the Western Wall.

Free afternoon in Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Sunday - Day Five - Jerusalem - The Jordan Valley - Galilee

This morning we attend the morning service at St George's cathedral. In the afternoon we transfer to Tiberias with a brief visit to Jericho. We continue to the Yardinet Baptism site.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Monday - Day Six - Around the Lakeside

This morning we visit Capernaum, where Jesus ministered, Tabgha site of the loaves and fishes and the Mount of the Beatitudes associated with the sermon on the mount. In the afternoon we drive to Caesarea Philippi, the source of the River Jordan.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Tuesday - Day Seven - Nazareth

We visit Mount Tabor which we ascend and descend by taxi and then enjoy a boat trip on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Wednesday - Day Eight - Caesarea

We leave Tiberias and drive to Caesarea where we visit the ampitheatre and aquaduct. Continue to airport for return flight to London Heathrow

Passports, visas and vaccinations

Travellers are responsible for ensuring that they have a valid passport for travel to the relevant countries and that it is valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel. Visas are not required for British Passport holders visiting Israel. At the time this brochure went to press no vaccinations or inoculations are required for travel but you may wish to consult your own doctor for advice concerning this. Further information and paying the balance

Further information will be sent to you regarding any action that may be required approximately 12 weeks before departure.

A final invoice will also be sent at this time and the balance for the tour must be paid at least 10 weeks before departure.

Travel information

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties

Travel insurance

It is compulsory to have travel insurance for your booking. Holiday Extras have a range of policies available at very competitive prices.

Gratuities

Our normal procedure is to deal with tips on a group basis and these are included in the price. The tour leader will distribute them to the guide, driver and hotels on your behalf. Individual tipping is not recommended unless the circumstances are exceptional.

Room check in and check out Times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 11am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.

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
